

Use these buttons to sign up to the RSS feed for the information or to view the extent of the information retrieved





## NAVIGATING AROUND THE MAP


There are different ways in which you can change your view of the map.

Firstly, you can zoom. If you want to zoom in (+) and out of the map (-) you can use the zoom scale bar. The nearer you are to the (-) the more area you will see. Alternatively the roller ball on your mouse can be used to zoom in and out.

Secondly, if you hold the shift key down on the keyboard and draw a box around the area you require preferably starting at the top right of the box you will zoom to that area.

Thirdly, you can use the 'pan' tools. If you need to shift the map in a North , South ,East or West direction you can do this using the map controls. You can also simply 'pan' around by clicking on the map, holding and moving the mouse and then releasing the mouse when you are at the location you require.

## AN OVERVIEW OF THE LOCALVIEW BUTTONS

-  ADDRESS SEARCH: Type in the address required and click search
-  Click and drag the pin to set a map location
-  HOME: View the original list of options (Local Features, Map Features and Contact Us)
-  LOCAL INFORMATION: View the list of local features (requires a map location to be set, either by searching for an address or dragging a pin onto the map)
-  CONTACT US: View a list of forms for reporting incidents or faults to Broxtowe Borough Council
-  MAP FEATURES: Turn features and layers on and off on the map with simple check boxes
-  RESET: Reset the map
-  NAVIGATION BUTTONS: Move north, south, east and west by clicking up, down, right and left respectively.



9.  ZOOM SLIDER: Zoom in or out of the map by clicking and dragging the slider up and down.

10.  RSS FEED: Click to sign up to RSS feeds for the relevant selected information

11.  ZOOM TO FEATURES: Zoom to the full extent of the information found

## NOTES

- If you can't find an address use a 'wildcard', typed as \*. These can be used if you are not sure about a spelling or how an address would appear. These symbols can be used to replace numbers, letters and/or spaces.
- LocalView remembers the last location you were at by means of a cookie on your pc.
- You can zoom to a specific area by holding down shift and clicking and dragging the map
- Reset the map with the reset button
