1. Search for an address or click a point on the map to set a location. Explore the results in the dialog box. Use the slider to set a radius from the selected location
2. Choose your basemap
3. Turn layers on or off
4. See what's turned on
5. ONLY AVAILABLE ON THE SHLAA MAP: Select a feature on the map (i.e. Neighbourhood Plan Area) and report out all SHLAA sites within that area
6. Information about the map
7. ONLY AVAILABLE ON THE MY POLLING STATION MAP: Find your address, view your polling station information and get directions.

TIPS ON SEARCHING ADDRESSES

1. Be as specific as you can (i.e. 3 Church Street Eastwood)
2. If necessary use the postcode to get you to the area required and then click to add a point over your property when in tool 1 or 7
