NOTICE OF MAKING

BROXTOWE BOROUGH COUNCIL (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER 2015

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th of December 2014 Broxtowe Borough Council made the above Order ("the Order") under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended and all other enabling powers.

The Order relates to existing off-street parking places and proposed new parking places provided by the Council at the locations listed in the Schedule of Parking Places and Charges below and is intended to come into operation on Monday 19 January 2015 (or as soon as possible thereafter).

The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottingham) Designation Order 2008 brought civil parking enforcement into force in the relevant areas of the County of Nottinghamshire, including the Borough of Broxtowe, on 12 May 2008.

The Broxtowe Borough Council (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2010 ("the 2010 Order") came into force on 5 April 2010 and revoked the Order of 2008 in its entirety. The 2010 Order implemented parking charging and permit-holder parking in the Borough of Broxtowe. It also extended the number and type of parking places available. The Broxtowe Borough Council (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Supplementary Order 2012 ("the 2012 Order") came into force on 17 February 2012 supplementing the 2010 Order. The 2012 Supplementary order enabled the Council to add some new parking places, revoke and amend the conditions of use of some existing parking places, therefore extending the number and type of off-street parking places available.

Pursuant to the Designation Order, The Broxtowe Borough Council (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 ("the 2013 Order") came into force on 21 October 2013 and revoked the Order of 2010 and the 2012 supplementary order in its entirety.

The Notice of Proposals to make the Broxtowe Borough Council (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Supplementary Order 2015 was published in the Nottingham Evening Post and advertised on site on 9th September 2014. The effect of the Order is as shown in that Notice of Proposals, with no amendments

The Order will not revoke the existing order (The Broxtowe Borough Council (Civil Enforcement Off-street Parking Places) Order 2013: 'the Existing Order'). The Order will supplement the Existing Order by adding some new parking places and by amending the conditions of use of an existing parking place, as described in the attached draft Schedule of Parking Places.

Proposed Penalty Charges

£70 (£35 where paid within 14 days; £105 if paid after service of charge certificate) For contraventions in relation to parking in loading areas; designated disabled persons bays; a restricted area; a permit bay or a bay not designated for that class of vehicle; for using a vehicle in connection with the sale of goods; and for causing an obstruction. For parking in a permit bay without clearly displaying a valid permit. £50 (£25 where paid within 14 days; £75 if paid after service of charge certificate)

For parking for longer than the maximum period allowed; parking beyond the bay markings; returning to the same parking place on the same day within the specified period; parking when the parking place is closed; parking for a purpose other than that permitted; parking with the engine running where prohibited. For contraventions related to parking charges, including: parking without payment of the parking charge; parking after expiry of the paid time; parking without clear display of the relevant ticket(s), voucher or parking clock; and parking without additional payment(s) to extend the parking stay.

SCHEDULE OF PARKING PLACES, TIMES AND CHARGES OF USE UNDER THE ORDER

1. Pay and Display Car Parks, Category A : Long Stay

Former fire station site, Beeston.

Permitted Times of Use: Public parking Monday to Saturday between 8:00am and 6:00pm with no time limit and a continuous period not exceeding 12 hours on all days. No return within 1 hour and only one free period per day.

2. Pay and Display Car Parks, Category B : Short Stay

Chilwell Road, Beeston and Wilmot Lane, Chilwell.

Permitted Times of Use: Public parking Monday to Saturday except bank holidays, but including Good Friday. Limited to 3 hours maximum and no return within 1 hour between 8:00am and 6:00pm and only one free period per day.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order (which was made on 5th December 2014) or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 5th December 2014, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
