Keep your MOTORCYCLE SAFE

Spend as much as you can afford on insurance approved security devices like ground anchors, tagging systems, and immobilisers. In addition to them protecting your machine you may be able to get a discount on your insurance.

At Home

- · Keep your bike out of sight in a locked garage.
- Secure it to an immovable object or consider installing a floor or wall-mounted anchor lock for extra security
- If you must leave it on a driveway fit a ground anchor and use a cover.

Whilst out

- Always lock your motorcycle and activate anti-theft devices
- Lock motorcycles to an immovable object. Organised thieves will lift bikes up and take them away in the back of a van, don't make it easy for them.
- Be careful where you park. Choose well lit, highly visible public areas, preferably covered by CCTV.
- Try not to lock your motorcycle in the same place on a regular basis, this may prevent it being stolen to order
- Whenever possible keep locks and chains off the ground – this prevents thieves from smashing them on tarmac or concrete with a hammer.
