2. Residents' Issues from the last meeting

ISSUE	OUTCOME
Parking outside a house on Wallett Avenue	Nottinghamshire County Council sent out enforcement notices. Residents confirm they have not seen the van
Legally but dangerously parked cars on Dennis Avenue	Spoke with the police – as car is legally parked they cannot do anything
A blue estate car has been parked on the corner of Fairfield Road for the last 2 weeks	A letter was posted by hand at the address – since then new tenants moved in. Residents confirm blue car not seen anymore
Speeding cars on Peveril Road	PCSOs did 3 evening speed tests but only 1 vehicle needed stopping. 30mph is too fast for this road so will continue to press for 20mph
Junction of Marlborough Road and Abbey Road	Due for consultation shortly – people will need to say they want speed bumps
Dog fouling sign needed on Wallett Avenue	Added to the "to do" list

3. Residents' Questions;

- Questions around Fracking were asked as this continues to be a concern. No applications received for this area.
- Sale of the Central Avenue Garages? – Not heard anything

Speeding on Walleth Avenue and Farfield Avenue	Steve/Barbara
Mopeds causing a nuisance/excessive noise by riding up and down Anderson Crescent and immediate area. They congregate on Anderson Crescent/Farfield Avenue	Steve/Barbara
Delivery men on Central Avenue still a problem	Steve//Barbara

6. Any Other Business

- Cllrs Carr recently attended a police briefing to look at what is happening in Broxtowe.
- Police numbers have dropped by 50% in the last 7-8 years. Crime has increased. This is a worrying situation.

Residents fear people will take matters into their own hands.

- As The Hope Centre did not come to open the venue, Cllr Carr will look to see if The Nurseryman pub is available for the next meeting. It is possible that it may be on the Tuesday as Mondays do not seem to be working for residents. Details will follow soon.
