THE ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014 PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER (STAPLEFORD) 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Broxtowe Borough Council intend, after the expiry of the period mentioned below, to make an Order under Section 59 Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, designating the area of Chilwell Nottinghamshire as shown edged black on the plan referred to in this Notice as a Public Spaces Protection Order area.

The effect of this Order is such that the police will have the power to require a person not to take part in car cruise events where motor vehicles congregate or take part in any activities associated with car cruising where the officer reasonably believes the person is, has or intends to do so. Failure to comply with an Officer's requirements without reasonable excuse is an arrestable offence. A person guilty of such an offence will be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the Standards Scale.

The Order will come into force on 17th January 2018.
