



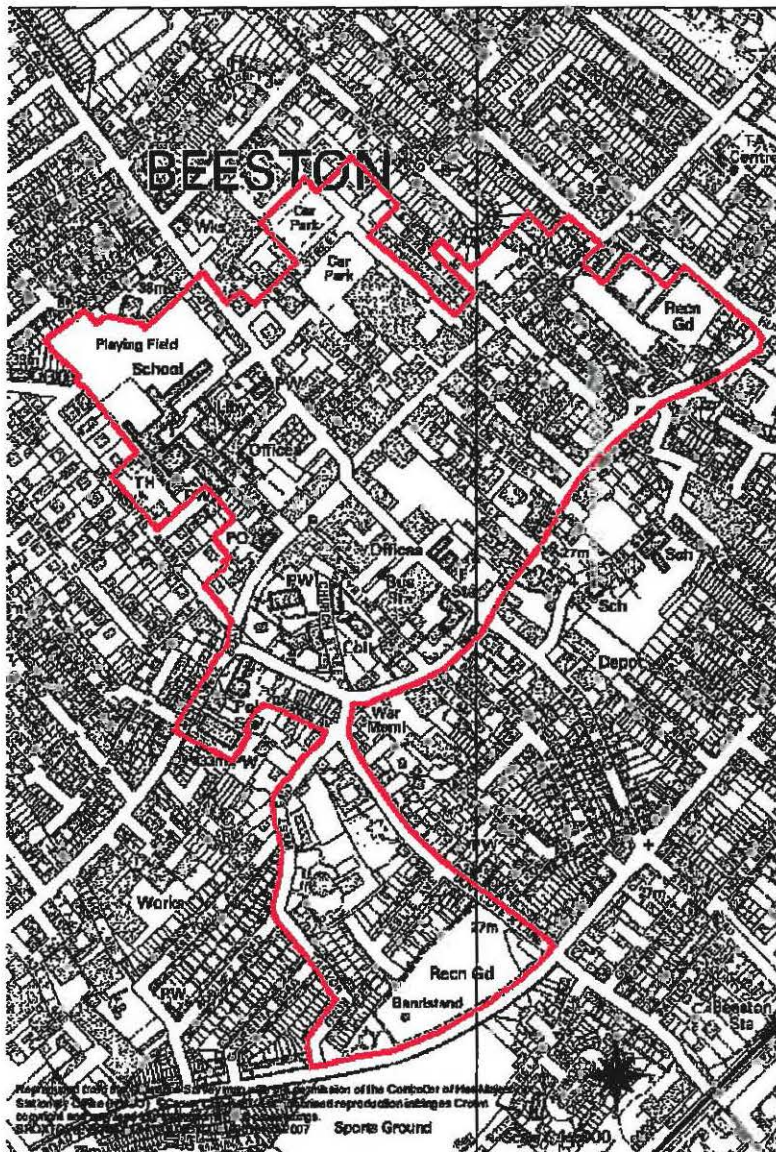
**BROXTOWE BOROUGH COUNCIL**

**BEESTON TOWN CENTRE PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Broxtowe Borough Council, using powers contained within the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 designate the area of Beeston Town Centre delineated red on the attached map as a Public Spaces Protection area.

The effect of this Order is that the police and authorised officers have the power to require a person not to consume intoxicating liquor where the officer reasonably believes the person is, has or intends to do so, and to surrender any intoxicating liquor or a container containing such liquor. Failure to comply with an officer's requirements without reasonable excuse is an arrestable offence. A person guilty of such an offence will be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
