



# Beeston North Community Action Team Minutes of Meeting Tuesday 24 October 2017

## 1. Welcome, Introductions & Apologies

9 residents attended the meeting, there were no apologies.

## 2. Minutes of the last meeting – matters arising

Steve reported back on the issues raised at the last meeting.

## 3. Residents' Issues

Residents raised the following issues of concern which Steve will address:

- Double parking on Dennis Avenue, Central Avenue, Markham Road and Wallet Avenue.
- Parking problems at the junction of Muriel Road and Abbey Road, outside the Hope Centre and the gates of Beeston Fields Primary School.
- A resident was concerned about vehicles accessing Beeston Cemetery late at night and in the early hours of the morning – could this possibly be the borough council's security company (Profile)?
- Mopeds on Fairfield Avenue.
- Overgrown tree outside Wollaton Road allotments.
- Trees on Central Avenue recreation ground at the Wollaton Road end are causing damage to the fence of a resident who lives on Wollaton Road.

## 4. AOB

Steve reported the following: -

- Some bin collection days will be changing but residents will be informed.

- The council owned garages on Central Avenue are to be demolished to build further housing – there is a possibility that the allotments on Central Avenue may also be built on. Steve has objected to this but negotiations are in early stages.
- Notts County Council is involved in energy provision for Nottinghamshire residents – see NCC website for more details.
- Steve mentioned that a petition about the A52 had gone to the Government. however, no action had yet been taken.
- Both Notts County Council and Broxtowe Borough Council are consulting about budgets – both consultations can be found on both council websites.
- Beeston Town Centre – on-going negotiations about the land opposite Tesco in Beeston. It is likely to be a cinema with housing and retail facilities. There are on-going discussions about the provision of public toilets in the centre of Beeston.
- Steve will investigate developing a neighbourhood plan.
- Sure Start Children’s Centres are under threat of closure – Steve will keep the group updated.
- Steve was asked by NCC Highways to prioritise highways issues in the area and he has suggested  
Marlborough Road  
Bramcote Road  
Lowes Estate  
Sandringham Drive
- Bramcote Hills School – the school is currently selling school land to raise funds for the rebuilding of new school premises.
- The development of a new Aldi store in Stapleford has been delayed due to negotiation of how many residential properties are to be built on the same land by Aldi.
