17. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

18. <u>MINUTES</u>

The minutes of the meeting held on 26 September 2017 were confirmed as a correct record, save that Councillor R D MacRae wished it to be noted that he had declared an interest in respect of minute no. 16 and that was the reason he had left the Chamber.

20. LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 1976 HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE

The Committee noted the hearing procedure, with particular reference to the Council's policy, natural justice and the code of conduct.

Members considered the representations made by the applicant, who appeared in person, the Council's licensing representative, the relevant legislation and the Council's Licensing Policy. The Council's Licensing Manager advised the Committee of an error on page 5 of the agenda and it was noted that the date of offence stated as being 09.04.2017 should read 09.04.2016.

The Committee advised the applicant to pay attention whilst driving on the road and to take the advice seriously and that if the applicant appeared before the Committee again then the licence may not be granted.

RESOLVED that the applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a hackney carriage/private hire driver's licence and the application be granted.
