3. Police Update

PCSO Andy Freeman attended the meeting and gave an update on crime in Stapleford:

- ASB although has decreased on this time last year is still an issue
- Off-road motorcycles
- Bicycles riding on pavements

Andy confirmed that they had a new Police Inspector at Beeston and a new Sgt and that commencing in the New Year there would be 3 officers for Stapleford and they were currently looking for a local venue where they could store kit and equipment. Andy explained to members of the public Policing prioritisations.

Residents raised the issue of ASB and drug dealing on Hickings Lane Park at all hours of the day and night also near the Doctors' surgery and the Co-op. Andy reiterated the importance of reporting incidents to Notts Police on 101 or Crimestoppers 0800 555 111.

4. What are your views on the future of local government in Nottinghamshire

Cllr RM wanted to gain the views of those present, and make people aware of Notts County Council's recent proposal to become a Unitary Authority.

5. Closure of the Bank

A petition was circulated at the meeting opposing the closure of the Lloyds bank in Stapleford. Cllrs have been collecting signatures and the petition has been signed by over 2,000 local people. Cllrs will be meeting with council officers and other banking providers to look at alternative financial services for local people. Cllrs will update on any outcomes.

6. Traffic Regulations Update

Cllr JM raised his concerns about the 2 road traffic fatalities that have occurred in Stapleford in recent months. Both Cllrs JM and RM will be meeting with council officers from Broxtowe Borough Council and Notts County Council to review traffic regulations in Stapleford and consider the possibility of introducing a 20mph speed limit on some roads with speed camera support. The roads identified are Church Street, Hickings Lane, Brookhill Street and Pasture Road. Councillors will feedback any progress at the next meeting.

7. Resident's concerns

Residents raised concerns for the Cllrs to address as follows:

- Drug dealing on Hickings Lane Park (as mentioned in item 3)
- Off-road motorcycles at Mackinley Avenue twitchell barriers are needed
- Double parking on the double yellow lines on Pinfold Lane adjacent to the new Aldi development – these are mainly works vehicles
- There were discussions about HS2 and Cllr RM informed residents about a public meeting about HS2 to be held at the Haven Centre on 16 November at 7pm

Cllr RM stated that at the Aldi development and the HS2 development should utilise local people for employment opportunities.

Cllr RM also stated that the 21 bus service was changing from a half-hourly service to an hourly service. He also wanted thanks recorded for the work that PC Hannah Ward put in to a recent project whereby local young people who were at risk of offending were supported through a programme of educational workshops on various subjects including offending and life skills.
