NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Broxtowe Borough Council proposes to review the current Public Space Protection Order made under Section 59 of the Anti Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014 in respect of footpath between Malthouse Close and Knapp Avenue Eastwood.

Restrictions are:-

All pedestrians and equestrians, other than those specified in the Order, will be prohibited from using the footpath between Malthouse Close and Knapp Avenue.

The Order will exempt any person who lives in premises adjoining the alleyway, emergency services personnel, statutory undertakers and utility providers from the restriction.

An alternative route for pedestrians and equestrians is available by using the roads Church Street and Knapp Avenue.
