1. Welcome and Introductions

Cllr RM welcomed everybody to the meeting.

3. Actions from the previous meeting

Cllrs RM and JM gave feedback about the actions from the previous meeting: -

- Drug dealing on Hickings Lane is not being reported to the Police and therefore no progress is being made on this issue
- Bicycle marking – 3 events have been completed resulting in approx 120 bicycles being post coded.
- Dog fouling – information about dog fouling is on the council’s website and posted on social media. Neighbourhood Wardens deal with dog fouling, stray dogs, fly tipping, graffiti etc. Contact details for the Neighbourhood Wardens is 0115 9173142 neighbourhood.wardens@broxtowe.gov.uk
Posters stating the fine for dog fouling are displayed in every park and open space and on every dog litter bin in the borough.

5. Update on Bramcote College

Paul gave an update on Bramcote College which is part of the Whitehills Park Federation and educates young people from 11 to 18 yrs of age. The college recently gained a good Ofsted report.

Originally the college was in the process of selling land on Coventry Lane to fund a new school building however it has been agreed that the leasehold of the land be transferred back to Notts County Council (NCC) in return that NCC will fund a new school building. It is anticipated that the land on Coventry Lane will go for private housing.

NCC has now passed the design of the building on to a firm of architects/designers. The final design will go before Planning in the autumn and then a consultation will take place. It is hoped that building work will commence September 2020, completed by autumn 2021 and will be occupied by January 2022.

The new building will house 600 students and it is envisaged that part of the building will be open for community events/meetings etc.

Details regarding the consultation and open evening will be displayed on the school website.
