Still awaiting Royal Consent for HS2. Nottingham to Birmingham intercity would still go ahead if HS2 did not.

CT explained that the Barracks will be decommissioned over time and not in one go. The TA's will still be based there

BBC wants to be carbon neutral by 2030. 1000 trees have been planted annually for last four years and now want to make this commitment 2000 trees annually. If you want a tree or know a piece of land suitable for planting please let the council know.
