### **NOTICE OF MAKING**

### BROXTOWE BOROUGH COUNCIL (CONSOLIDATED) CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER 2020

Notice is hereby given that on the **31st of January 2020** Broxtowe Borough Council made and formally sealed the above Order ("the Order") under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended and all other enabling powers.

The Order relates to existing off-street parking places provided by the Council at the locations listed in the Schedule of Parking Places and Charges below and is intended to come into operation on **Monday 16 March 2020** (or as soon as possible thereafter).

The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottingham) Designation Order 2008 brought civil parking enforcement into force in the relevant areas of the County of Nottinghamshire, including the Borough of Broxtowe, on 12 May 2008.

The Order restricts use of the parking place covered by this Order to vehicles of a specified class parked in such positions, on such days, during such times and for such periods as specified at each parking place; and prohibited parking in bays marked for use by disabled persons unless the vehicle is displaying a valid Disabled Persons Badge and currently set time clock.

The Notice of Proposal to make the Order was published on site at each parking place and in the Nottingham Post on **18<sup>th</sup> November 2019**. The effect of the Order is as shown in that Notice of Proposal, with no amendments.

## Proposed Penalty Charges

£70 (£35 where paid within 14 days; £105 if paid after service of charge certificate) For contraventions in relation to parking in loading areas; designated disabled persons bays; a restricted area; a permit bay or a bay not designated for that class of vehicle; for using a vehicle in connection with the sale of goods; and for causing an obstruction. For parking in a permit bay without clearly displaying a valid permit.

£50 (£25 where paid within 14 days; £75 if paid after service of charge certificate) For parking for longer than the maximum period allowed; parking parking place is closed; parking to the same parking place on the same day within the specified period; parking when the parking place is closed; parking for a purpose other than that permitted; parking with the engine running where prohibited. For contraventions related to parking charges, including: parking without payment of the parking charge; parking after expiry of the paid time; parking without clear display of the relevant ticket(s), voucher or parking clock; and parking without additional payment(s) to extend the parking stay.

#### 1. Pay and Display Car Parks, Category A:

Victoria Street, Eastwood. Albion Street, Derby Street (South), Middle Street, Station Road (Central) (Former Multi-storey car park site), Former Fire Station and Portland Street Beeston.

**Permitted Times of Use:** Public parking Monday to Saturday between prescribed times with no time limit and a continuous period not exceeding 12 hours on all days. No return within 1 hour and only one free period per day. Blue badge holders up to 3 hours free no charge £0.00, normal charges apply therefore after

#### 2. Pay and Display Car Parks, Category A3:

Devonshire Avenue, Beeston: permit holders only except Saturday and Sunday between prescribed times, with no time limit and a continuous period not exceeding 12 hours and no return within 1 hour.

**Permitted Times of Use:** Public parking Saturday and Sunday between prescribed time with no time limit and a continuous period not exceeding 12 hours on all days. No return within 1 hour and only one free period per day where applicable. Permit parking Monday to Friday between prescribed times.

#### 3. Pay and Display Car Parks, Category A2:

Cliffe Hill Avenue, Halls Road, Stapleford. Victoria Street, Kimberley. Sun Inn, Oxford Street Eastwood. Derby Street (Middle), and Middle Street (central) Beeston.

**Permitted Times of Use:** Public parking Monday to Saturday between prescribed times with no time limit and a continuous period not exceeding 12 hours on all days. No return within 1 hour and only one free period per day. Blue badge holders up to 3 hours free no charge £0.00, normal charges apply therefore after

#### 4. Pay and Display Car Parks, Category B:

Foster Avenue, Chilwell Road, City Road, Wilmot Lane, Regent Street, Beeston. Eatons Road and Victoria Street, Stapleford. Scargill Walk and King Street, Eastwood.

**Permitted Times of Use:** Public parking Monday to Saturday, with no time limit and a continuous period not exceeding 12 hours on all days. No return within 3 hours between prescribed times and only one free period per day. Blue badge holders up to 3 hours free no charge £0.00, normal charges apply therefore after

# 7. Zero-Charge Car Parks, Category C2: General

King Georges Park, Bramcote, (as amended)

**Permitted Times of Use:** Public parking Monday to Friday except bank holidays, but including Good Friday between prescribed times limited to 3 hours. No return within 3 hours.

## 8. Permit Only Parking Places, Category D : Permit

Derby Street (Residents), Foster Avenue (Police permit parking area) Regency Court, Bradley Court, Jessamine Court, Yew Tree Court and The Lilacs (Housing), Station Road Service Yard and Styring Street Service Yard, Beeston. Victoria Street and Wellington Street (Housing) Eastwood. Rockwell Court (Housing) Stapleford.

**Permitted Times of Use:** Permit parking Monday to Sunday (inclusive) No time limit and 24 hours on all days.

# 9. Pay and Display Car Parks, Category H :

Station Road, Beeston and Technology Drive, Beeston

**Permitted Times of Use:** Public parking Monday to Sunday inclusive, with no time limit and a continuous period not to exceed 7 days. Except bank holidays, but including Good Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order (which was made on **31st January 2020**) or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from **31st January 2020**, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
