

Pride In Parks

Our Pride in Parks initiative has seen £887,000 invested in parks and open spaces across the Borough since 2018 thanks to Council and external funding. A further £535,000 of Council funding has been committed over the next three years and we hope to secure additional funding to support this.

Brinsley

£36,000 for general play area

- improvements, replacement outdoor gym equipment and a disabled access swing at Brinsley Recreation Ground.

Eastwood

- £28,000 play area improvements at Mansfield Road Recreation Ground.

Awsworth

- £5,000 for play area improvements at Shilo Recreation Ground and major improvements to the cricket pavilion at The Lane Recreation Ground thanks to Pride in Parks and external funding. Most recently £3,000 was spent on habitat improvements at The Lane Recreation Ground.

Trowell

- £14,000 of play area improvements at Trowell Parish Hall.

Stapleford

- £165,000 for a new play area and multi-use games area at Hickings Lane Recreation Ground. £15,000 Scheme to upgrade play area at Judson Avenue.

Bramcote

- £124,000 to create a new play area and provide outdoor fitness equipment at King George V Park.

Greasley

- £57,000 improvement Scheme at Beauvale Park Play Area, with additional work proposed this financial year, using Section 106 funding provided from a local housing development scheme.

Kimberley

- 3 play area schemes have been completed. £20,000 on new equipment at Millfield Road, £25,000 on a new fenced area for young children at Knowle Park and a £85,000 improvement scheme at Hall Om Wong. The scheme at Hall Om Wong also included access/environmental improvements and references to the sites heritage. Work has also been undertaken to improve the bowls pavilion and green at The Stag Recreation Ground.

Nuthall

- £47,500 play facility improvements at Redbridge Drive and £30,000 at Basil Russell Playing Fields. A further scheme at Basil Russell saw new outdoor fitness equipment and outdoor table tennis facilities provided together with improvements to the sports pavilion.

Beeston

- £87,000 improvements at Broadgate Park and £100,000 for major improvement works at Leyton Crescent Play Area thanks to Pride in Parks and external funding. A further bid has recently been submitted for external funding for a full refurbishment of Dovecote Lane Recreation Ground Play Area. Works are proposed for early 2021.

Chilwell

- £42,000 improvement scheme at Sherman Drive Open Space has been completed with a further £42,000 scheme at Swiney Way in autumn 2020.
