Your Ornamental Tree

Prunus serrulata 'Pink Perfection' (Japanese Flowering Cherry)

'Pink Perfection' is a small deciduous tree with compact crown of ascending branches. Leaves open bronze, later green, with some orange tints in autumn. Double, light pink flowers 5cm in width in drooping clusters in late spring.

Prunus serrulata 'Shimidsu' (Japanese Flowering Cherry)

'Blushing Bride Cherry Blossom'. A small, slow growing deciduous flowering ornamental cherry, with an elegant vase shape, wide spreading habit. It has large, double flowers that hang down in big bunches from April-May, opening pink and fading to bright white. Leaves turn from green to orange in autumn.

Prunus × subhirtella 'Autumnalis Rosea' (Winter-Flowering Cherry)

'Autumnalis Rosea' is a small deciduous tree of spreading habit with ovate leaves turning yellow in autumn, and pale pink, semi-double flowers opening during mild weather from late autumn to early spring. *Grow in any moist well-drained soil.*

Prunus × yedoensis 'Shidareyoshino' (Japanese Flowering Cherry)

'Shidare-yoshino' is a cultivar with weeping branches, arching to the ground. It produces a profusion of racemes of 5 or 6 bowl-shaped, pale-pink flowers, fading to nearly-white and 4cm across, in early spring before the dark green leaves emerge.

Prunus serrulata 'Shirofugen' (Japanese Flowering Cherry)

One of the prettiest Japanese Flowering Cherry trees, Prunus 'Shirofugen' is popular for its long lasting display of large pink buds which cover the branches in spring. The buds open up into fragrant, large double white blooms which fade to pink with age. The blossom appears in April-May and can adorn the branches into early June.
