 - Specialist heavy goods vehicles
 - Light commercial vans
 - Tractors
 - Ride on Mowers and Plant including an extensive range of hand operated equipment used by the Council's service departments
- 2. Assist with diagnosing faults, undertake repairs and prepare vehicles for their annual MOT tests (HGV & LGV).
- 3. Understand how to apply professional motor industry standards with regards to Road Transport, Health and Safety at Work law.
- 4. Assist with completing vehicle maintenance administrative records.
- 5. To take part in meetings, supervision and training and other events to assist with your development as requested by your line manager.

- 6. To undertake training leading to a recognised apprenticeship qualification
- 7. Carry out any other duties that are within the scope and grading of the post.
