INDEPENDENT PERSON

ROLE DESCRIPTION

- 1. To attend regularly and participate in meeting of any Committee established to deal with the conduct of Members, including consultative meetings/informal dispute resolutions with the Monitoring Officer and/or Members [Note: meetings may be held during the evening as well as during the day and may require travelling between Councils within the County. Consultations may also take the form of a telephone/Microsoft team conversation or email correspondence].
- 2. To participate as an independent person in hearings in relation to complaints of Member misconduct under the Code of Conduct.
- 3. To actively promote ethics and standards within the Borough Council, Town and Parish Councils within the Borough.
- 4. To develop and apply knowledge of the Code of Conduct in relation to matters alleging breaches of the Code of Conduct.
- 5. To assist in the preparation of reports and determination of allegations or Member misconduct in conjunction with the Monitoring Officer and Council Members.
- 6. To analyse and exercise fair and impartial opinion on conduct issues and to set standards of ethical behaviour.
- 7. To develop a sound understanding of the ethical and wider regulatory framework.
- 8. To be aware of the views of the local community on ethical standards and to reflect those in carrying out the role.
- 9. Be prepared to undertake training and to participate in training events organised by the Council to promote awareness of the Code of Conduct.
- 10. To attend meetings of the Council and civic and other functions in order to raise the profile of ethics and standards within the authority.
- 11. To assist and be an impartial advisor to the Monitoring Officer on complaints and allegations made against Members.
- 12. To participate as an Independent Person in any Disciplinary Panel set up to make recommendations on any disciplinary actions in respect of a Chief Officer.
- 13. To undertake such other representations as the Monitoring Officer considers reasonably commensurate with the position.
