COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT REVIEW

At its meeting on 29th July of Kimberley Town Council discussed the proposals made in your document dated 17th May 2021.

It concluded:

1. Cloverlands Estate. This Council opposes the transfer of some properties on the Cloverlands estate to Greasley Parish on the grounds that a) these residents are closely linked to Kimberley town center with well used pedestrian access via Edgwood Road, b) vehicular access via Cloverlands Drive leaves them much closer to Kimberley facilities than any that exist in Greasley and c) they undoubtedly feel themselves part of Kimberley.

The Council counter proposes that the whole of the Cloverlands Estate should transfer to Kimberley with a new boundary enclosing Chilton Drive, Beryldene Avenue and the whole school site together with Newdigate Road and Corbiere Avenue properties so enclosed.

2. Babington Village. This Council suggests that the views of residents be canvassed before transferring them to Awsworth.

3. Nuthall Parish Proposals. This Council opposes the proposals that Nuthall Parish Council have made to transfer a large part of the Larkfields Estate to them from Greasley and/or to create an expanded parish incorporating the Watnall residential area in to Nuthall Parish. In both cases the Council would argue that these areas are more closely linked to Kimberley and its facilities.
