RESPONSE TO COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW 2021 CONSULTATION

Thank you for consulting Stapleford Town Council on the above review. The Town Council considered the information and some possible options around the review at its meeting on 17 September 2021.

The Town Council has agreed with the Borough Council's initial recommendations but has also decided to put forward an additional proposal to be considered alongside. This is mapped for you in the attached documents but essentially would see the southern boundary of the parish restored to its historical lines.

There are a small number of properties where the addresses are in 'Stapleford' but sit in a 'no man's land' between Stapleford and Toton. I have enclosed an additional figure which shows these and sets out some of the information about them which the Council believes would support them being included in the Town Council's boundary.

There are some properties which can only be accessed via Bessell Lane and so they must go through Stapleford to access other roads and services. This also means that they would have to drive past a Stapleford polling station to go to vote in Toton.

The properties related to the Bardhills Garden Centre are also addressed as 'Stapleford' but the Garden Centre itself is linked heavily with Stapleford too and so the properties are considered to be linked to the community of Stapleford.

I trust this is enough information for you in the first instance but if you should require further clarification then please do not hesitate to get in touch.
