



Bramcote Neighborhood forum AGM 25 8 2021 20.00 hrs

4. Treasurers report. No money has been spent in the last 12 months.

5. Chairs report
 - a. a different year due to covid
 - b. Been going for 5 years and [REDACTED] mentioned the members of the steering group who have retired ([REDACTED]).
 - c. Interest in joining the steering group
 - d. Appetite energy and motivation to renew the forum for another 5 years
 - e. Our plan had been submitted and had basically been lost by the person who replaced an outgoing member of the council. The info from June 2020 needed to be resubmitted and this was done by December. [REDACTED] shared Gantt chart from council. There was no referendum despite the forum meeting all the designated targets. We also had responses from the members of Bramcote and this was also handed in.
 - f. At the end of January, it was submitted and accepted and the council then asked us to make changes. This did not happen so the plan should go out for consultation.
 - g. The neighbourhood plan and documentation are with the council and Broxtowe are not doing anything with it. They are now concerned about the status of the forum despite their 18 month delay

- [REDACTED] asked to be reminded of the remit of the forum.
 - h. White Hills Park Federation updates. Sale and development has been decided upon to fund the redevelopment of the school. Freehold goes to the federation. Broxtowe plan changed the number of houses to 500 dwellings (to include the Brethren church lands) and this is now reflected in the submitted Neighborhood Plan. The land on the other (west) side of Coventry Lane, in Stapleford, is subject to a planning application submitted a few weeks ago.

- [REDACTED] asked about timescale. It will be mid 2023 at the very earliest. [REDACTED] mentioned that the school's timetable has not been accurate (2016). Stapleford land application does not fit in with the council's local plan. [REDACTED]: movement by the end of the year.

- i. Appeal against refusal for buildings on the ridge has failed. Golf course is being looked at. HS2 and Chetwynd barracks are also issues on the horizon. This will change the context in which Bramcote sits. In 2028 there will be a new decision about house allocation.

██████████: Next local plan should not be so dramatic and be concentrated in the North of the borough. Discussion of the 6000+ houses plan. ██████████: We are ahead of where we expected to be. ██████████: new government legislation takes planning away from local communities. Discussion of town council, parish councils and forums.

- j. Broxtowe review of aligned core strategy: local plan part 2 (2 years) and forums have not been invited to that and silence from the council about the core strategy review.
- k. Future of the forum invited to reapply for redesignation. The area does not change, the plan is submitted but the forum has ended. Long discussion about the role of the forum and its future without more input from local people. ██████████ slowly co-opted...
- l. ██████████ and ██████████ will lock horns to hammer out a way in which to get more people motivated to keep a forum.
