

Broxtowe Counter Terrorism Situational Risk Assessment Summary 2026

The current threat level for Nottinghamshire is **SUBSTANTIAL**. Substantial indicates that an attack is likely.

Prevent Referrals:

There has been an increase in prevent referrals and in casework with the majority of the referrals coming from the Police, Education, Health and Local Authorities. Most referrals are males with the ages ranges 11-21 and 30-50 being the most common. 16% of referrals in Broxtowe are repeat referrals.
